Dear Parents and Families:

As indicated in Saturday's email communication, beginning Tuesday morning, students should check PowerSchool and their RamsNet email each day for information from teachers about assignments. They should also be vigilant in checking any other services that teachers have instructed students to use for their particular classes.

Below, you will find details concerning the plan we have developed for continuing your son/daughter's education via remote methods.

- RamsNet will be the primary email system for all communication with students by teachers.
- Each teacher will develop a daily lesson, designed to last approximately 40 minutes, for their students. Students should plan to be actively engaged in academic work for a minimum of four hours per day.
- Teachers will list all assignments in PowerSchool, but actual assignment descriptions and other information may appear in another system (RamsNet; Teams, etc). The assignments will be available by 8 AM each day, for each class.
- Students must submit their daily work (in whatever format is requested by the teacher) by 3 PM that day. The submission of the work will count as the student's attendance in that class for the day.
- Teachers will be available for quick email response during their "Virtual Office Hours", listed on the attached document. Teacher email addresses (for parent contact) are listed next to their hours. Teachers will respond to emails at other times during the day also; these "virtual office hours" are simply a period of time during which we are trying to guarantee near-immediate response. Students should use RamsNet email to contact their teachers.
- As with any absence, if your child is too sick to complete any work on a given day, please notify Shannon Gorman (sgorman@gchsrams.org or 856-298-7982) by 9 AM.

Please continue to monitor email, student RamsNet email, our school website and other GCHS social media for continued updates and information.
