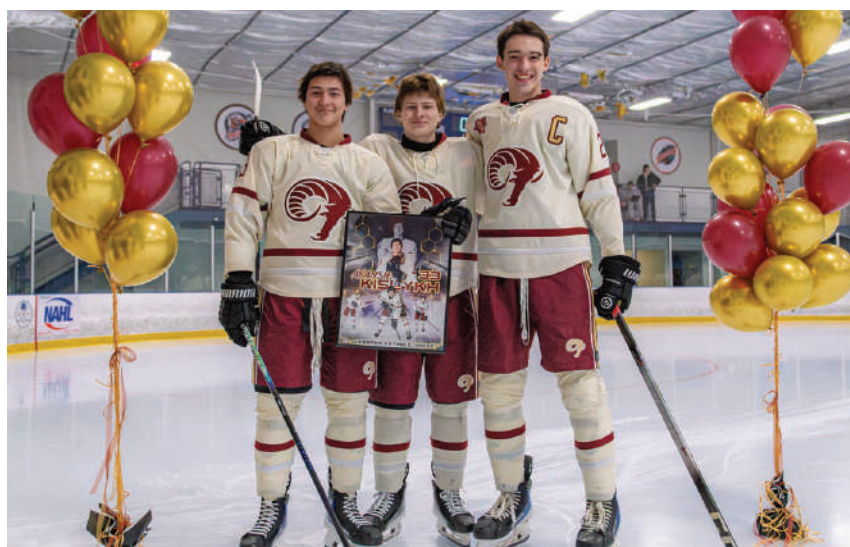

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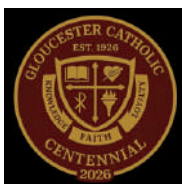

JOYFUL GIVING

Barbara and I often describe ourselves as “**joyful givers**”. We weren’t always able to give much, but we’ve learned that generosity isn’t measured by the size of a gift, it’s measured by the heart behind it.

When I was a child, putting a quarter in the Sunday collection basket was a big deal. My family didn’t have much, but that quarter meant we were part of something bigger than ourselves.
